Each week for an hour on Monday afternoons students will be able to explore an area of their choice with support from staff. After further investigating this idea and evaluating the success students have in the skills of inquiry we believe that this is a fantastic opportunity not only for students to dive deeper into a topic of their own choosing but to also spend this time collaborating with students from different grades. Students will create their own driving question, research their topic and share their findings with an audience.


