### Celebrations and community gatherings moving forward

It was great to have so many parents and carers join us last week for our Easter Mass in the Morley Centre. I'm sure everyone who was part of our community for this Mass would agree that the singing was outstanding and the children were very reverent and respectful.

As the current COVID19 restrictions in relation to school gatherings allow 100 external visitors indoors and 200 visitors outdoors, we are hoping to return to 'in person' Celebration of Learning and Parent University this term. As Parent University is an indoor gathering in one place, parents will need to be registered to attend to ensure we can follow the COVID safety plan and current restrictions on physical distancing. At this stage we plan on holding three time slots for the Celebration of Learning on Wednesday 16th June at 4.30pm, 5pm or 5.30pm. The Parent University for Term 2 will focus on Mathematics and will be at 6pm, also on Wednesday 16th June, for those parents interested.
