Online Canteen - Update for Parramatta Schools previously using "Welcomeasy"

As you would appreciate, COVID has had a significant impact on many small businesses. Canteen operators in primary schools have not been spared.

Since Welcome Easy ceased operations in the Parramatta area, our schools have made several attempts at attracting a new service provider. This has to date proven challenging, with potential operators citing staffing issues and cost as the key barriers to service provision. Of the few vendors who have expressed interest in partnering with our schools, our principals' collective view is that they are unlikely to meet the standards set by Welcomeasy or Tuckshop2You, the service providers replaced by Welcomeasy.

Whilst we cannot promise a quick resolution to the lunch service issue, rest assured that we are endeavoring to find a suitable replacement.
