COVID Updates

Thank you to all in the community for your continued support in complying with our current COVID restrictions. The NSW Government did announce yesterday some easing of restrictions; once we have confirmation and clarification of possible changes to restrictions in schools, we will communicate these to the community - this may include a return to the normal 2.45 pm finish for the whole school, but any changes will be communicated as soon as possible.

Thank you for your support in monitoring your child for COVID twice a week, using the Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs). As you know from the regular updates, we have had community members in some specific year groups impacted by COVID. Thank you for communicating any positive results to the school as soon as possible. Students learning at home because they are either positive to COVID19 or they are a close family contact can be supported with some online learning activities.

RAT (Rapid Antigen Test) supplies - additional deliveries next week

We have been notified that the school will be receiving another two-week supply early next week. We will collate these into family sets and distribute them to the eldest child in each family. If you would prefer to collect these yourself, rather than being sent home with the eldest child, you can collect them from the school office from next Thursday afternoon. Spotlight on Stage Three RE:



How to get started with Qkr!:


1. Install the Qkr! app on your smartphone.


