

Primary Choir Opportunity

In the coming weeks, Mrs Grainger and Mrs Antoun will be auditioning students who would like to be a part of the Mother Teresa Primary School Choir. In previous years, our school choir has participated in CAPTIVATE choral eisteddfods. This year, the Diocese has invited Primary Schools to participate in a Choral presentation in Term 3, with other Catholic Primary schools in the Diocese at Blacktown. Many thanks to one of our Mums, Mrs Rebecca Romanous, who is supporting us with the preparation of the music for our school choir.

Half-yearly reports and Parent-Teacher Interviews

The teachers are currently writing the Semester One (or half-yearly) student learning reports. These reports indicate student progress and achievement in Key Learning Areas for the first semester, as well as indicating the qualities your child displays at school as a learner. You will receive these reports on Thursday, 23rd June. In the final week of this term, parents and children will also have the opportunity to book in a time, either via zoom or face to face, to meet with your child's teacher. A letter outlining how to book in for an interview will be shared with families next week.

Skoolbag to Compass

Our school will be changing the way we distribute our written communication in the coming weeks. Currently we use this Skoolbag platform. Mother Teresa Primary will be gradually moving our communication platform over from Skoolbag to the Compass Parent Portal. Compass is a web-based system allowing you to access important information about the school. Most schools in the Parramatta Diocese already use the Compass platform for operations like student attendance and record keeping. If you have daughters at Catherine McAuley High School you will already be using this platform for communication. Parramatta Marist High will also be shortly moving to the Compass parent portal.

All parent communication will be shared electronically via email and the Compass app. It is very important that we have your latest contact information updated in our records. We do ask that if you have recently changed your email address or phone number and have not already notified the office, that you do so by emailing your new contact information and your children's name to motherteresa@parra.catholic.edu.au
This will ensure we have the latest information and you do not miss any important messages from the school.

Please note, as we are gradually moving to the Compass parent portal, we will be using our <u>existing booking system for our half-yearly parent teacher interviews</u>. Our Mother Teresa Primary school reports are formatted differently to the Compass Student Learning Reports, so you will not be able to access Compass Student Learning Reports through Compass at this stage.

Term 2 - Celebration of Learning and Parent University (Religious Education)

Our Term 2 "Celebration of Learning" will be held on Wednesday 22nd June between 4.30 pm and 6 pm. This is an opportunity for your child to show you around their Learning Studio and discuss the learning they have completed in Term 2. Following our "Celebration of Learning," we will have our Term 2 Parent University. Last term our focus was on Mathematics, this term our focus will be on Religious Education, led by Fr Walter and Mrs Gaye Dennis (REC). All parents and carers are welcome to come along to our Parent University for Term 2.

Staff Development Days 2022

Each year, all schools in NSW are allocated 6 Staff Development Days (SDD) to use for teacher professional development and learning. This year, the Government and CEDP (Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta) have allocated one additional SDD due to the fact that a new syllabus is being phased in to all Primary Schools in NSW over the next two years. We have already used our first two SDD at the beginning of the year for teacher professional learning and for the MAI (Mathematics Assessment Interviews).

In Term Two we will be using the final day of term to work with the Staff of Sacred Heart Primary and Fr Walter on formation and spirituality. This means that the final school day of Term 2 for the children will be Thursday 30th June.

In Term Three, the staff will have a day focussed on literacy. This SDD will be a pupil-free day and will be held on Friday of Week 5, the 19th of August.

In Term Four, the first day of term will be a SDD focused on the new NSW syllabus for Primary Schools. This means the first day of Term 4 for children will be Tuesday 11th October. The final day of Term 4 (and the final day of the year for students) will be Friday 16th December (Friday, Term 4 Week 10). The following week MTP staff will be gathering with the other schools in the Westmead Catholic Community for Mass and further professional learning and planning for 2023.

As part of the Sporting Schools program, MTP will be holding AFL clinics for the next four weeks with stage 1 and 2 during their regular sport lessons.



2. Use the magnifying glass to search for Mother Teresa Primary.






- 4. Once you have created a profile, you may view available items and purchase them.
