Protected Industrial Action Friday, 27th May

As notified through Skoolbag today, on Friday, 27 May 2022 a number of our staff may take part in protected industrial action (stop work action) to progress their claims for a new enterprise agreement. It is not known at this time how many staff members will participate.

I want to assure you that supervision will be provided at school on this day, however, no classes will be held. Given this, we strongly encourage families not to send their children to school on this day given the potential reduction in staff. Our staff are within their rights to take protected industrial action.

Catholic Education Diocese Parramatta and other Catholic Dioceses across NSW and the ACT have regularly met with the union to progress negotiations for a new enterprise agreement and will continue to do so.

Thank you for your understanding and I will continue to keep you updated about this matter.

Term 2 - Celebration of Learning and Parent University (Religious Education)

Our Term 2 "Celebration of Learning" will be held on Wednesday, 22nd June between 4.30pm and 6:00pm. This is an opportunity for your child to show you around their Learning Studio and discuss the learning they have completed in Term 2. Following our "Celebration of Learning," we will have our Term 2 Parent University. Last term our focus was on Mathematics, this term our focus will be on Religious Education. All parents and carers are welcome to come along to our Parent University for Term 2.

Staff Development Days 2022

Each year, all schools in NSW are allocated 6 Staff Development Days (SDD) to use for teacher professional development and learning. This year, the Government and CEDP (Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta) have allocated one additional SDD due to the fact that a new syllabus is being phased in to all Primary Schools in NSW over the next two years. We have already used our first two SDD at the beginning of the year for teacher professional learning and for the MAI (Mathematics Assessment Interviews).

In Term Two we will be using the final day of term to work with the Staff of Sacred Heart Primary and Fr Walter on formation and spirituality. This means that the final school day of Term 2 for the children will be Thursday, 30th June.

In Term Three, the staff will have a day focussed on literacy. This SDD will be a pupil-free day and will be held on Friday of Week 5—19th, August.

In Term Four, the first day of term will be a SDD focused on the new NSW syllabus for Primary Schools. This means the first day of Term 4 for children will be Tuesday, 11th October. The final day of Term 4 (and the final day of the year for students) will be Friday, 16th December (Friday, Term 4 Week 10). The following week MTP staff will be gathering with the other schools in the Westmead Catholic Community for Mass and further professional learning and planning for 2023.

Our Year 6 students had a fantastic time at Wedderburn Christian Camp a couple of weeks ago. This was an opportunity to spend time in the great outdoors, challenging ourselves and getting to know each other in a different environment, While this experience was a lot of fun, I would like to thank all of the staff who gave up their time to accompany our Year 6 students on camp.

- To help children develop the vital road-crossing skills they will need as they become mature pedestrians.
- To reduce the car dependency habits that are being created at an early age and which will be difficult to change as children become adults.
- To promote the use of Public Transport.
- To reduce the level of air pollution created by motor vehicles.
- To reduce the level of traffic congestion.

How to get started with Qkr!:


1. Install the Qkr! app on your smartphone.



2. Use the magnifying glass to search for Mother Teresa Primary. Touch the school name to select.



3. Select Add Profile and create a profile for each student at the school.




- 4. Once you have created a profile, you may view available items and purchase them.
